### Points of Special Interest

- Berggasse 19, a historic site: rooms open to the public in Sigmund Freud's former office and private apartment. From 1891 to 1938, Sigmund Freud lived in the building at Berggasse 19, a typical Viennese apartment house in turn-of-the-century style
- Original furnishings in the former office's waiting room
- A selection of personal effects and objects from Freud's extensive collection of antiquities
- Numerous unique original documents from the papers of important figures in the history of psychoanalysis
- Exclusive historic film material showing scenes from the Freud family's private life in the thirties is on view in the video room (the family's former kitchen). The film material was compiled and commentated by Anna Freud.
- A collection of contemporary art exhibited in Anna Freud's former private rooms and office
- A series of installations by international artists in the building's storefront (left of the main entrance of house number 19)
- Temporary special exhibitions
- Free access to the library (open Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.)
- Museums shop with books in a number of languages (ca. 400 titles) as well as an extensive selection of gift items
