



Conditions for renting the Event Hall in Sigmund Freud's former private apartment at Berggasse 19

- The Event Hall can only be rented between 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. because the Sigmund Freud Museum is housed in a residential building where the noise ordinance must be observed after 10 p.m.

- Only the facilities for which prior authorization has been granted may be used.

- Equipment is available for use as arranged in advance.

- All Museum safety and security regulations must be strictly observed.

- Any damage incurred before, during or after the event and resulting therefrom will be charged to the renter.

- Sigmund Freud Foundation personnel shall supervise setup and cleanup work but may only become directly involved in coordinating the event through prior written agreement.

- Smoking or use of open fire is strictly forbidden on the entire Museum premises.

- The renter must name a contact person who shall be present until the end of the event and who shall assume responsibility in writing for the observation of the regulations stipulated above and for leaving the facility in an orderly condition.

- All materials printed in connection with the event, in particular invitations, are to be presented to the Sigmund Freud Foundation for approval before duplication. The location of events shall without exception be specified as:
