THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE COMMUNICATED WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT TO EXPEDITE MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE IMMIGRATION OF DR. HARTMANN AND HIS FAMILY.

THE COMMITTEE ALSO MADE IT POSSIBLE FOR THE BANK STREET SCHOOL TO ESTABLISH A SCHOLARSHIP FUND, CALLED THE HARTMANN SCHOLARSHIP FUND, AND TO INVITE DR. HARTMANN TO COME TO THE SCHOOL ON A CONTRACT, THE FUND TO BE USED AS SALARY. FOR THIS PURPOSE THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE FOUND A SPECIAL CONTRIBUTOR WHO LOANED THE NECESSARY \$4,500.00. SUBSEQUENT \$2,000.00 WERE REFUNDED TO THE DONOR, THE REMAINDER WAS MADE A CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMITTEE. (Emergency Committee)

THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE COMMUNICATED WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT TO EXPEDITE MATTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE IMMIGRATION OF DR. HARTMANN AND HIS FAMILY.

THE COMMITTEE ALSO MADE IT POSSIBLE FOR THE BANK STREET SCHOOL TO ESTABLISH A SCHOLARSHIP FUND, CALLED THE HARTMANN SCHOLARSHIP FUND, AND TO INVITE DR. HARTMANN TO COME TO THE SCHOOL ON A CONTRACT, THE FUND TO BE USED AS SALARY. FOR THIS PURPOSE THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE FOUND A SPECIAL CONTRIBUTOR WHO LOANED THE NECESSARY \$4,500.00. SUBSEQUENT \$2,000.00 WERE REFUNDED TO THE DONOR, THE REMAINDER WAS MADE A CONTRIBUTION TO THE COMMITTEE. (Emergency Committee)
