VIENNESE PSYCHOANALYST

IN APRIL, 1938, SHE WROTE TO THE EMERGENCY COMMITTEE FROM PRAGUE, ASKING HELP IN SECURING AN AFFIDAVIT. THE COMMITTEE COMMUNICATED WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT IN HER BEHALF. IN JULY, 1938, DR. REICH ARRIVED IN NEW YORK AND THE COMMITTEE TRIED TO FIND A PLACE IN WHICH SHE COULD LOCATE. SHE REMAINED IN NEW YORK CITY; HOWEVER. IN 1940 AND 1942 THE COMMITTEE INTERVENED WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT IN BEHALF OF DR. REICH'S FATHER, ABOUT WHOSE IMMIGRATION THERE WERE SOME DIFFICULTY.
